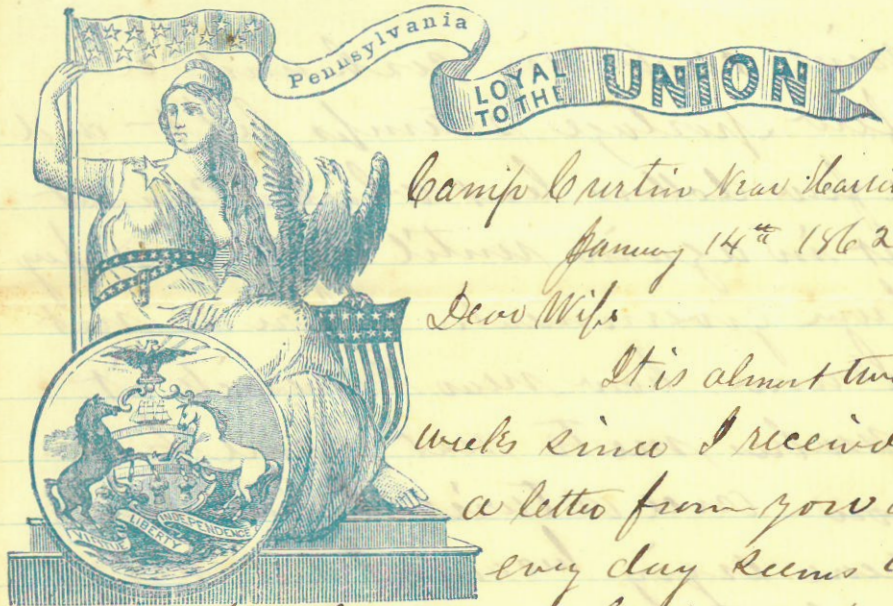


I will send you one soon

Camp Curtin near Harrisburg Pa
January 14th 1862
Dear Wife

It is almost two
weeks since I received
a letter from you and
every day seems to
me to be about a week. do not
delay so long again. I think that
your letter must have been mis-
carried. I have had the blues for
a week and they are caused by
nothing else only that I do not
hear from you I wrote to you
last week & directed to be closed
the 16th is the last day of grace for
us to fill up this Reg^{ts} and we are
only about half full.

We have not received one cent
of pay as yet and I have only
