that I was threatened with Typhoid fever but  
I am better this morning and am able to be up <sup>around</sup>  
I have had no fever since yesterday noon & think with  
due care I will be able for duty again by tomorrow  
or next day. I have a good standing here in this  
Regt and all seemed to be very anxious about me  
and well they might be for they cannot get another  
person to do what I have done & take as good  
care of the sick. I have the good will of all and  
especially of those that have been unfortunate enough  
to be sick in Hospital. Our first man died  
Saturday night at 11 o'clock since I have been  
in Hospital. I shall come home as soon as  
we get to Baltimore if I do not get my discharge  
I have got those pictures you sent me Photographed  
but have not been able to go and get them yet  
Webster is going after them this morning for  
me. I attended the arch at theatre the other evening and  
saw the Comedy of Errors played enclosed send you  
the bill played when I was there excuse a short letter  
this morning as I do not feel much like writing  
yet And believe me yours in love
