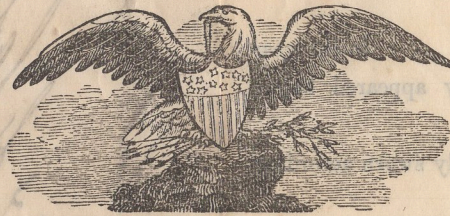


To all whom it may Concern.



Know Ye, That Newton F Marsh — a private — of Captain  
John Bactus's — Company, (E.) 58<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Penn Volunteers who  
was enrolled on the First day of October one thousand eight hundred and Sixty One  
to serve three Years, is hereby Discharged from the service of the United States,  
this Sixteenth day of April, 1862, at Camp Hamilton Virginia by reason  
of an order from the Secretary of War dated April 12 - 1862 -  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)\*

Said Newton F Marsh — was born in Cattaraugus County — in the  
State of New York, is thirty three years of age, Five feet Seven & 1/2 inches  
high, Fair complexion, Grey — eyes, Brown — hair, and by occupation, when enrolled,  
a Physician

Given at Camp Hamilton Va this Sixteenth day of April 1862.

\*This sentence will be erased should there be any thing in the conduct  
or physical condition of the soldier rendering him unfit for the Army.
