I was a little sick on yesterday I lay down & dropt to sleep I thought Much slept in & laid him on my breast I felt his soft sweet face so plain It woke me up I looked round around & felt like he surely was not far off but could not see him O Josephine I cannot let you stay much longer the weather is beautiful now if it will only stay so the roads will soon get good Every thing looks like the middle of April I have never seen the yard look so pretty & to day is warm enough for ~~me~~. I have peas mustard lettuce & onion & some cabbage up but I fear the full moon in April - Mrs A Williams was here the other day says tell you she wants to see more than any one she knows unless it is Mariah - Lou & Mirah Conley was here they told me to give you a great deal of love all the Neighbours when they come say they miss you so much they dont like to come - They worry me wanting to know when you are coming home - I tell them some time this summer Lydia & Virgil went from here on Monday all well our love to Elisha tell him the girls to return his compliments Willis & Althea left here on Monday on the 20<sup>th</sup> - Althea has her health a little better the little babe is a nice pretty little thing.
