Adelbert Harvey Marsh Harriet Zemira Smith Marsh

John Marsh a native of England born AD 1635 came to Boston Mass in the year 1669 and to distinguish him from all other John Marsh was called John Marsh of Boston. By his wife **Sarah** three sons were born to wit ??? **Joseph** and **Bartholomew**. **Joseph**, second son of John and Sarah married **Anna Thoroughgood** March 2 1691 By which marriage two sons were born to wit Joseph and John.

Joseph son of Joseph and Anna Thoroughgood born December 23 1694 [Anna was born in 1672] removed from Boston to Medford Mass in the year 1717 and was there married and in 1729 removed to Sturbridge Mass (later Douglas). The public records there show that he owned land in 1746, that the first town meeting of Douglas was held at his house and that he died in 1761 leaving surviving children to wit

Thomas [born Oct 6 1728] at Douglas Mass married **Hanna Fairbanks [born] July 27 1724** was an officer of the *town* of Douglas in 1765 a tax payer in 1766 died in 1769.

Jesse Marsh son of Thomas Marsh and Hanna Fairbanks born at Douglas Mass Dec 16, 1761 was a soldier in the war of the revolution was at West Point at the time of the Arnold and Andre affair was pensioned in 1832. For military records see records of the Secretary State at Boston Mass and at U.S. Pension Office at Washington D.C.

Jesse Marsh as appears upon the Town records of Douglas Mass, married **Charity Stearns** January 25, 1789 . the daughter of Eliphalet Stearns, a descendent (preacher) from Isaac Stearns, a native of England coming to Salem Mass June 12, 1630 died in 1661 leaving among his several children a son **Isaac**, born in 1632 who married Sarah Beers June 24, 1660. By the marriage of Isaac and Sarah Beers three sons were born one of whom Isaac born August 23 1665 who married Elizabeth Whipple Star by this marriage nine children were born among whom a son

Ebenezer who was baptized July 8, 1711 at Lexington Mass who married Sept 1, 1734 Thankful Clapp (?). By the marriage of Ebenezer and Thankful Clapp was born August 19, 1736 a son Eliphalet (sometimes otherwise called Eliphaz) who married Hannah Clark at Walpole Mass Nov 17, 1760 settled at Douglas Mass. Later removing to Dover VT died at Dover VT April 4, 1803 was a soldier in the war of the revolution.

Arba Marsh, son of Jesse and Charity Stearns Marsh married **Artemisia Jones** at Dover, VT [about] 1825.

Artemesia Jones was the granddaughter of Abner Perry and daughter of Ebenezer Jones and Anna Perry Jones born at Dover VT December 29, 1804 died at Allegany NY January 17, 1879

Abner Perry was a descendent from Captain George Barbouer the

Puritan (?) leader of Dedham and Medfield who came to America in 1635.

Abner Perry was born July 17, 1755 died Sept 2, 1834 was a soldier of the Revolution. Enlisted into the army April 25, 1775 as a private on the Lexington Alarm Roll. For more complete War record see record of the Sec of State at Boston Mass and Bureau of Pensions at Washington DC.

Abner Perry married Anna Phipps at Halluriston (?) Mass later removing to Wardsboro VT. Six children were born among whom Anna born July 18, 1782 married Ebenezer Jones at Dover VT March 25, 1801. By this marriage three sons and one daughter were born to wit

Artemesia Jones was a descendant from Thomas Jones a native of Caversham, Oxfordshire England who came with his wife Anna and elder children on board the ship Confidence to Hingham Mass in 1638 later settling at Hull Mass. Their children ??? were Joseph Benjamin Abraham and Robert.

Abraham, son of Thomas, among his several sons left a son Abraham who became prominent holding offices of trust at Hull Mass leaving among his several children a son John who later settled at Mendon Mass who among his several children had a son John born March 22, 1744 who married Abigal Ohenry Dec 19, 1762 born Nov 20, 1743. By this marriage ten children were born to wit.

Newton Franklin Marsh married May 17, 1853 Aurelia Burt born May 16, 1835 leaving at the time of his death one daughter Ada Gertrude born April 8, 1856 and one son Adelbert H. born Jan 24, 1863, had been a practicing physician at Ellington NY more than forty years.

Adelbert Harvey born May 7, 1833 married at Allegany NY April 17, 1856 Harriet Zemira (?) Smith born Oct 19, 1835 only daughter [Note: below three other children are listed] of Franklin Smith and Harriet Moore (?) Smith.

Anna Jane born Feb 5, 1836 died Dec 5, 1904 married Edward Stearns at North Olmstead Ohio August 1, 1852 who was born in 1831 and died in Dec 1904 leaving at the time of their death one daughter born April 8, 1856 and one son Arthur Adelbert born in 1858.

Franklin Smith born in Sitchfield County Conn. August 20, 1800 died at Allegany NY in 1841 {Feb 24} was the son of Jeremiah Smith who settled at Walcott near Nagatuck CT prior to 1778. Married Betty Clendand (?) April 29, 1786.

By the marriage of Jeremiah Smith and Betty Clendand eleven children were born Jonas Isaac _____ William _____ Jedediah Jeremiah Philo Hiram Franklin _____ and Hester _____

Franklin settled in early life at Windsor Broome County NY. There married in 1821 Harriet Moore the daughter of James Moore and Kate Youngs Moore and in about 1830 removed with their sons to Burton NY (later Allegany) Cattaraugus County NY. By the marriage of Franklin Smith and Harriet Moore Smith four children were born to wit

Allison Orlando born at Windsor NY in 1822 died at Olean (?) NY in 1869.
 William H born at Windsor NY October 24 1824 died at Fredonia NY June 3, 1898 where he had stopped on his way from California to Allegany to visit his sister Mrs. ???.
 Hampton M born at Windsor NY March 25, 1827 died at Oakland CA Dec 13, 1895.
 Harriet Zemira born at Allegany October 19, 1835 married Adelbert H. Marsh at

Harriet Zemira Smith a descendant on her mother's side from Christopher Young born in England in 1565 was of Welsh ancestry. A vicar of Southold (?) England from 1611 to 1626 - Among his several sons was one John born at Southold England in 1598 became a minister of the Calvinistic faith removing with his family to Salem Mass in 1639 and in 1640 settled at Southold on Long Island establishing a church there was its Pastor until he died 1671 - 2 became eminent in his Profession and one of the most prominent among the early settlers of Long Island. Among his several sons was one Christopher born in 1642 died in 1695 was a mariner by occupation and among his several sons was a son Christopher born in 1677 died at Aquebogue (?) Long Island June 28, 1727 was a farmer by occupation he leaving at his decease a son David born in 1712 died January 18, 1755 Married Mary Penny, by the marriage of David and Mary Penny six daughters and one son were born, their son also named David born at Aquebogue in 1744 died October 1, 1814, became impressed in early life that it was his due to preach the gospel and was ordained as a minister in 1783.

Rev David Young married in 1763 Abiah Sweesy (?) by which marriage several sons and daughters were born. A daughter Kate born Aug 28, 1764 and died at Windsor NY May 28, 1823.

Kate Young, the daughter of Rev David Young and Abiah Sweesy, married James Moore in 1785 at Aquebogue L.I. James Moore was born in 1757 died at Windsor (?) NY Sept 30, 1836. By the marriage of Kate Young and James Moore eight children were born to wit
